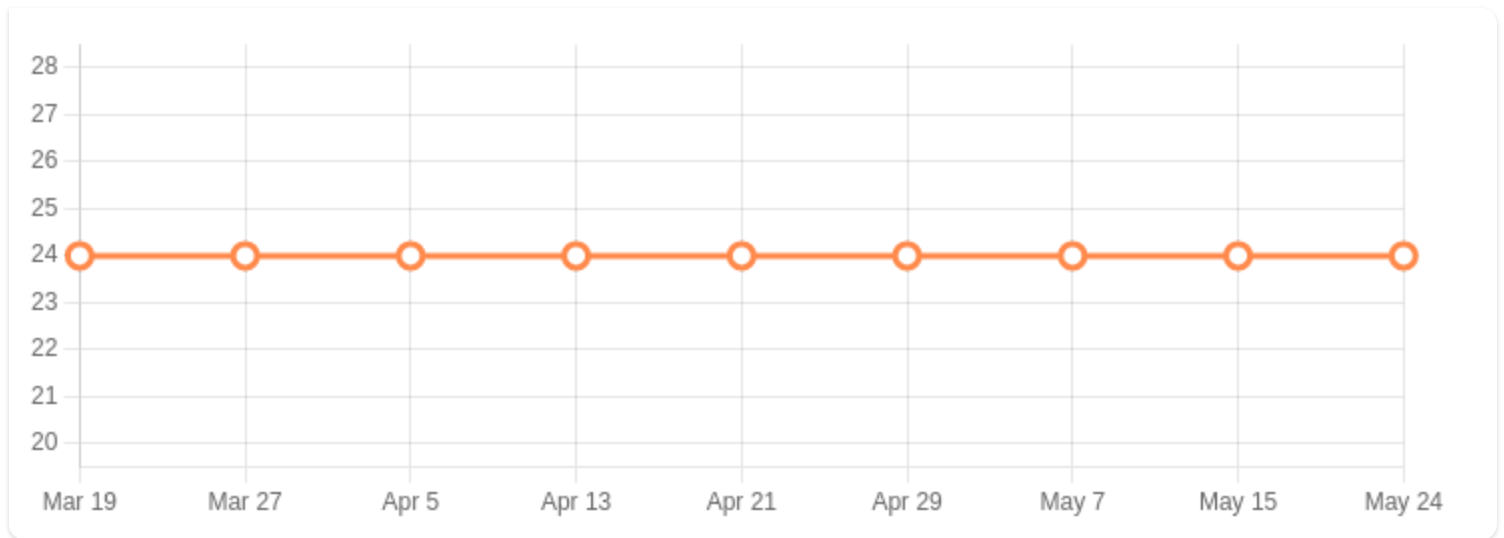

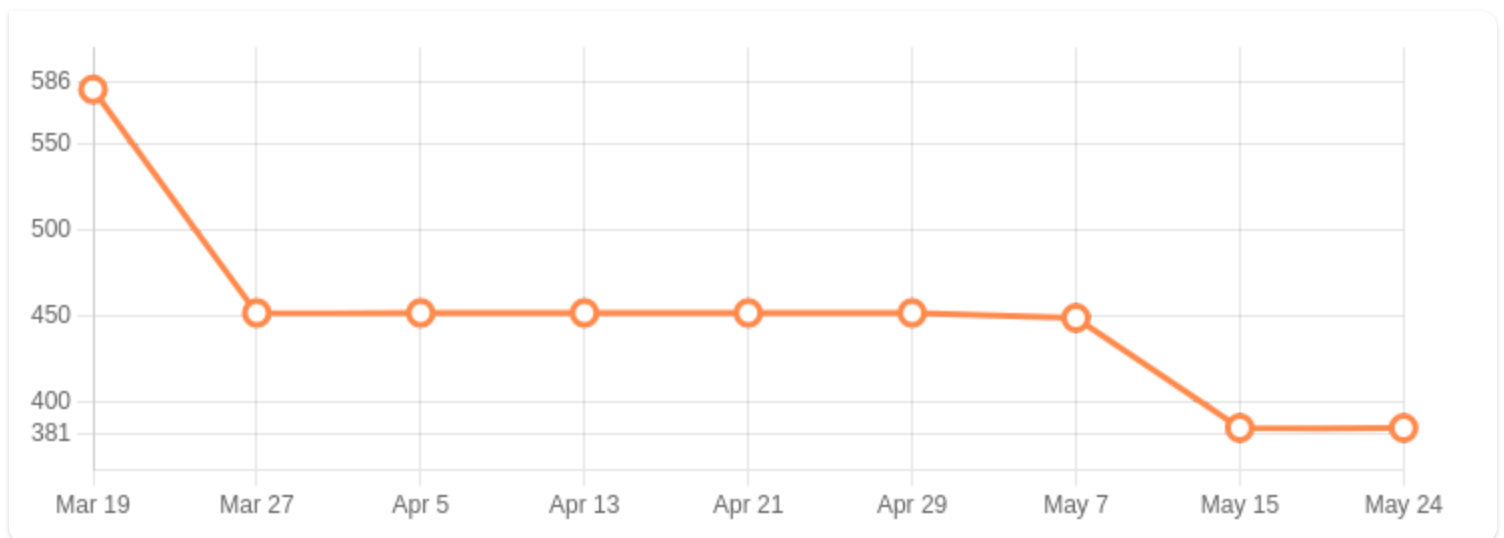

### **Issue #5 The contrast ratio of text with its background must meet WCAG AA requirements**

This failure occurs when text does not have sufficient contrast against its background, making it difficult to read for users with low vision. Text must meet WCAG AA contrast ratios to ensure readability across different visual needs.

#### Instructions:

- First determine whether the text is considered normal or large: Large text: 18pt or larger, or 14pt or larger if bold (needs 3:1), Normal text: anything smaller (needs 4.5:1)
- Adjust the text color, the background color, or both until the contrast meets the required ratio. If the background is an image or gradient, consider adding a solid/opaque background behind the text (or a dark/light overlay) so the contrast stays consistent.

### **Issue #9 The keyboard focus indicator should be visible when default border or outline is modified by CSS**

This failure occurs when CSS changes remove or reduce the default focus indicator, making it hard to see which element has keyboard focus. Keyboard users rely on a clear visual cue, so focused elements must remain clearly visible through an outline, border, or other strong visual styling.

#### Instructions:

- Use the keyboard to tab to this element. If you can quickly and confidently tell that it has focus, no changes are needed.
- If the focus indicator is hard to see or missing entirely, add a clear visual style when the element receives focus. This could be a thick outline, a visible border, or a noticeable background change.

## **Issue #32 A tabbable element should be visible on the screen when it has keyboard focus**

This failure occurs when a keyboard-focusable element is off-screen or not visible when it receives focus, leaving users without any indication of where they are on the page. Any element that can receive keyboard focus must be visible on screen when focused, or removed from the tab order if it's not meant to be interactive.

### **Instructions:**

- First, decide whether users should be able to interact with this element using the keyboard. If it should not be keyboard operable, remove it from the tab order (for example, set `tabindex="-1"` on a custom focusable element, or remove the interactive behavior entirely)., If it should be keyboard operable, use Tab (and Shift+Tab)
- to confirm the element becomes visible on screen when it receives focus.
